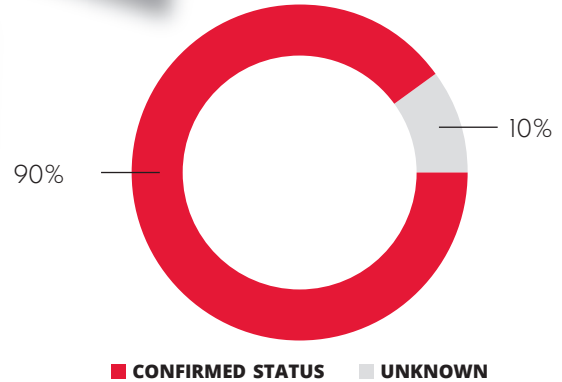

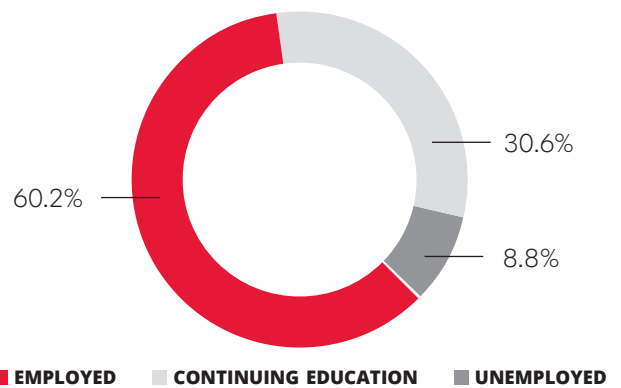
Employed Graduates with Salary Information
