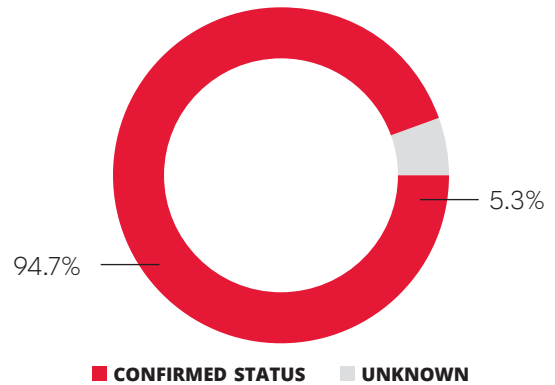

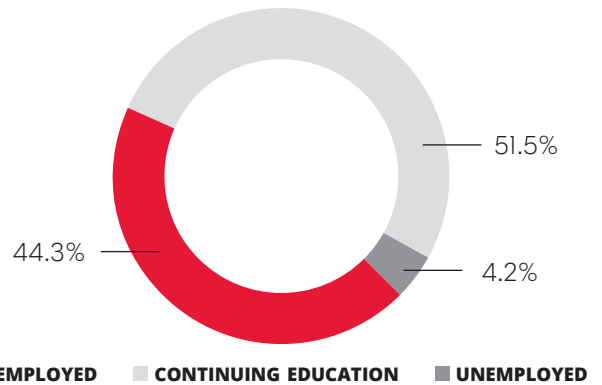
### Employed Graduates with Salary Information
